

FINANCIAL HELP

New starters living over 2 miles away from college who are facing financial difficulties due to transport costs may be eligible for some assistance. The **Student Bursary Fund** is designed to help students who are, or whose families are, on a low income or in particular financial difficulty. Application forms are available from the Finance Office and evidence of household income would be necessary as funds are limited.

If a suitable Warwickshire County Council or public transport does not operate near to your home, an annual travel allowance of £110 (or £220 if the student is from a low income family) is available. Subject to conditions.

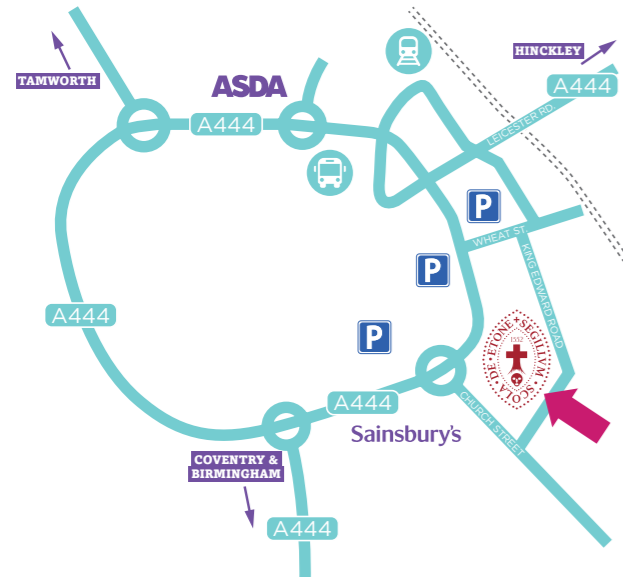
TRAVELLING BY CAR

TRAVELLING BY BUS

Stagecoach has a number of discounted ticket options available.

Scholar passes are only valid for those attending college on college days.

Mega Scholar passes are valid for those attending college and can be used for travelling at all times.

Nuneaton Megarider tickets cover the whole of Nuneaton.

Nuneaton Megarider Plus tickets cover the whole of Hinckley, Nuneaton and Bedworth, as well as Atherstone, Bulkington, Exhall, Mancetter, Gun Hill, Old Arley, Earl Shilton, Barwell, Leicester and Coventry.

Megarider Gold tickets cover Stagecoach Midlands operating area including services to Coventry, Tamworth & the whole of Warwickshire.

Arriva Student Saver bus passes can be used on Arriva and Hinckleybus services.

The **ZonePlus Saver** covers journeys into Leicestershire including service 7 to Hinckley and Burbage, 66 to Stoke Golding and Wykin, and 158 to Hinckley, Earl Shilton and Leicester.

The **West Midlands Saver** covers journeys into Staffordshire including service 65 to Atherstone and Tamworth.

Student Savers are available as a paper ticket or mobile ticket on your phone. For full details visit arrivabus.co.uk/student-saver-tickets/.

You can apply directly to Stagecoach or Arriva for a bus pass. You will be eligible for STUDENT DISCOUNT, upon production of your College ID card.

TRAVELLING BY TRAIN

If you prefer to travel to College by train then it may be worth purchasing a 16-25 railcard. It costs £30 and saves you 1/3 off rail fares. However it can only be used off peak and a minimum fare of £12 applies to all journeys made before 10am Monday-Friday. This does not apply on public holidays or in July/August. If you do travel to College regularly before 10am a weekly or monthly season ticket may be the best way to save money. For more information visit www.16-25railcard.co.uk.

NUS EXTRA CARD

For a further 10% discount on advance tickets with Cross Country trains, you can apply for an NUS extra card, at a cost of £12. Once you have the NUS extra card, just visit crosscountrytrains.co.uk/nus enter your details, select your journey & if valid the discount will be applied.

Alternatively download the CrossCountry train tickets app and enter your NUS extra card number in the 'Railcard and Promotions' section. Once within the journey search, the discount is automatically applied.

16-18 PHOTOCARD

16-18 year old students can apply for a 16-18 photocard. Applicants must be in full time education and live within one of the seven District Council areas of the West Midlands County i.e. Birmingham, Coventry, Dudley, Sandwell, Solihull, Walsall or Wolverhampton. This entitles the student to child rate season tickets or child rate cash fares to and from College within the Network West Midlands area, travelling either by train, bus or metro. You must submit your 16-18 application online at www.networkwestmidlands.com/16-18.

Request a Unique Validation Code (UVC) leaflet from the College. Without this UVC code you will be unable to apply for your 16-18 photocard. For details on all tickets, prices, areas of validity and to apply for Direct Debit visit www.networkwestmidlands.com or telephone 0845 303 6760.

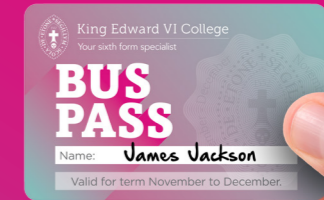
